5. Brief description about the event:

The Research and Development Centre of SMEC had organized an FDP on **Research Pedagogy and Contemporary Research** from **23-06-2022 to 25-06-2022**. 

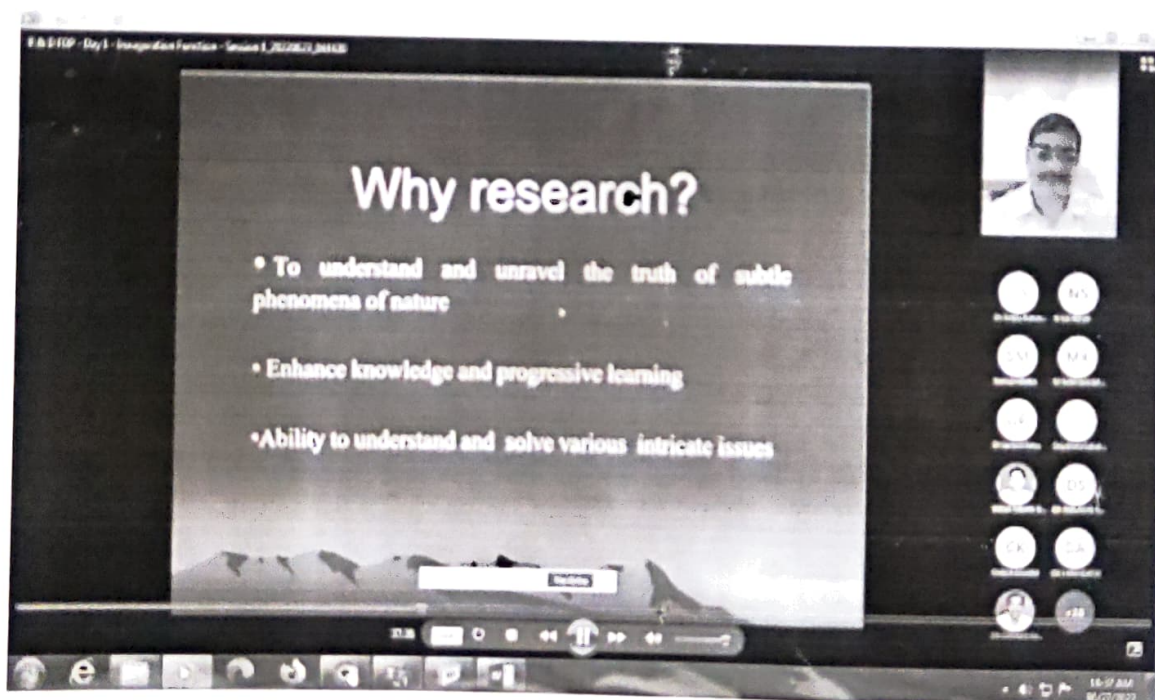
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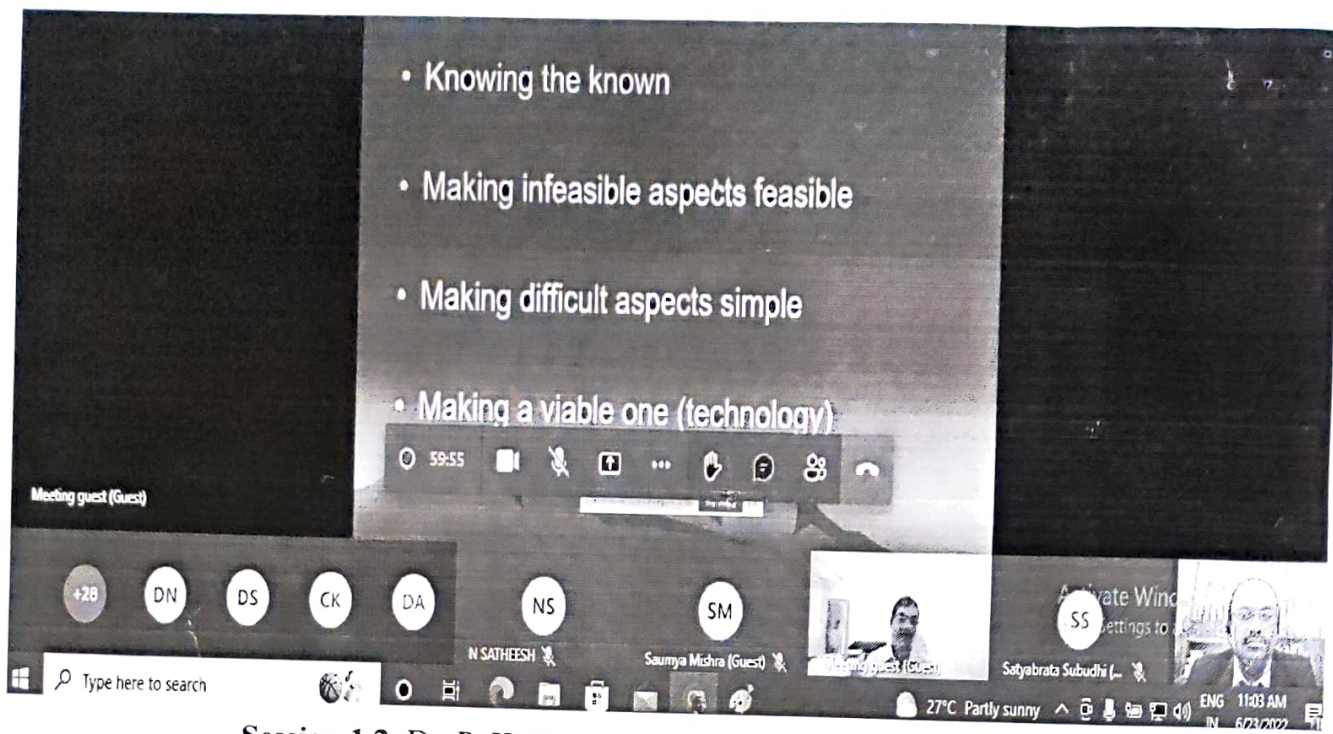
